

Abstracts, papers and presentations

The PhD students are obliged to present the essential themes and issues of their PhD project. To participate in the course all students have to forward an abstract of this not later than the 14th of July 2010. The size of the abstract has to be at least 500 words and max 1000 words.

Students who participate without presenting a full paper receive 4.0, while students who present an accepted full paper receive the maximum of 7.5 ECTS.

Students who participate with a full paper must focus on a subject that draws relations between the above mentioned issues of their PhD studies and at least one of the methodological traditions presented in the program (Practice Research, Discourse and Narrative Approaches to social work, Life Story Analysis and Institutional Ethnography). These papers will be reviewed by the teachers of the course and they must be accepted as having a sufficient quality. The size of the papers has to be at least 5.000 words and max 10.000 words.

The full papers must be received before the 1st of August 2010. The students will receive a response to and a critique of their paper the 11th of August.

Students presenting only an abstract must prepare a 10 minutes presentation of their PhD project. Students presenting accepted full papers will be given 15 minutes for presentation and 15 minutes for discussion/feed-back.
